

Cookie Jar Syllables

These cookie jar picture sorts are a fun way to help children learn syllables.

Instructions:

1. Sit in a circle and lay out the three syllable cookie jars in the middle.
2. Pick up one cookie at a time. Say the name and model how to identify the syllable.
3. The children need to look at the cookie, identify the number of syllables and place it on the corresponding cookie jar.

Notes: In my class I use body beats to help children identify syllables. So for a two syllable word, I place my hands on my head for the first syllable and my shoulders for the second syllable. Some other helpful strategies include clapping, tapping a finger on the drum picture for each syllable or placing your hand below your chin as you say each word.
